1. **VENUE:**

• The event will take place in the Delegates Dining Room, which is on the 4th floor of the Conference Building, at UN Headquarters, New York from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

2. ACCESS TO THE BUILDING AND EVENT PASSES:

- The Event pass will be distributed at South East Corner of the 46th street and 2nd Avenue and will be available to be picked up on the day of the event 27 September from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm.
